VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE
IN LIEU OF PROSECUTION

I, Jodie Lee Edge, M.D., being of lawful age and after first being duly sworn, depose and state and follows:

1. I hereby voluntarily surrender my Oklahoma medical license no. 6865 and retire from the practice of medicine.

2. The surrender of my license is freely and voluntarily made. I have not been subject to any coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the consequences of the surrender of my license.

3. I am the subject of a Complaint before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision involving allegations that, if proven, would constitute grounds for disciplinary action by the Board.

4. The allegations to which I have plead guilty are as follows:

A. From January 3, 2003 until December 31, 2003, Defendant wrote or authorized excessive prescriptions for Schedule II, III, and IV controlled dangerous drugs to ten (10) patients for alleged chronic pain all as set forth in the Complaint filed herein. Defendant's charts on these patients reveal that he failed to perform a sufficient physical examination on the patients prior to prescribing the controlled dangerous

drugs, and that he did not establish a legitimate medical need for the medications in accordance with published standards.

B. Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:

i. Failed to maintain an office record for each patient which accurately reflects the evaluation, treatment, and medical necessity of treatment of the patient in violation of 59 O.S. §509 (19).

ii. Prescribed a drug without sufficient examination and establishment of a valid physician patient relationship in violation of 59 O.S. §509(13).

iii. Prescribed a controlled substance without medical need in accordance with published standards in violation of 59 O.S. §509(17) and OAC 435:10-7-4(2) and (6).

iv. Excessively prescribed controlled or narcotic drugs in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(1).

5. I have, as of the date hereof, fully retired from the practice of medicine and I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license. I understand that I may teach medical students, interns, and residents but that I may not practice medicine in any form, prescribe, dispense, or administer drugs.

6. I hereby agree that I will not apply for reinstatement of my Oklahoma medical license for a minimum of one year from the entry of the Order Accepting Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution, and that if the Board ever reinstates my Oklahoma medical license, it will be under terms of probation to be set by the Board at the time of reinstatement.

7. As a condition to accepting my surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board may require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and costs, and any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.

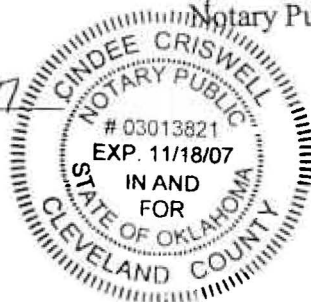


