ORDER OF CONTINUANCE UNDER CERTAIN TERMS

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on January 12, 1991, at the office of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C. Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Diane Fay Meier, O.T.A., Defendant, appeared by announcement of counsel, Shera D. Shirley, Enid, Oklahoma.

Before any testimony was taken, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision heard an oral motion for continuance on behalf of the Defendant, and said continuance was recommended by the Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee and therefore being fully advised in the premises, the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision finds that said motion by Defendant's counsel should be and the same is hereby granted under certain terms and conditions.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. That hearing on the instant case should be and the same is hereby postponed to the next meeting of the Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee.
- 2. That during the time of the continuance, Defendant will submit biological fluid specimens to include, but not limited to, blood and urine, for analysis, upon request of any investigator or other agent representing the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. Defendant will pay for testing and analysis of those specimens.
- 3. That during the time of the continuance, Defendant shall secure from her supervising Occupational Therapist a report on her work status and professional activities, with one report to be obtained at the end of December, 1990, and the second report to be obtained prior to the Committee meeting.
- 4. That the Committee shall be immediately notified in the event the Defendant discontinues present employment as an Occupational Therapy Assistant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that staff for the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision shall advise the Defendant and defense counsel of the exact date and time of the continued hearing by providing a copy of the Order of Continuance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant specifically reserves all defenses and the right to plead those at a later date.
