Dear Doctor Peter:

The Board in regular session on June 11, 1969, took the following action:

" ***motion was duly made, seconded, and carried, that he be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years with the provisions that he surrender his narcotic permit and order forms, that he not register for a narcotic permit during his period of probation, that he comply with the provisions of the Medical Practice Act and the Federal and State Narcotic Laws and other drug laws during the period of probation, and that he appear before the Board once a year, unless excused by the Secretary of the Board; further, that he keep the Board advised of his whereabouts and activities, and that he consult a psychiatrist, of his own choice, sending periodic reports to the Board of his progress prior to each appearance before the Board. It is further required that he advise the Board of his plans in this respect within three days after receiving this notice. Failure to comply with the provisions of the probation will result in the automatic revocation of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma".
