ORDER

On the 21st day of September 1979, this cause came on for hearing before the State Board of Medical Examiners. The plaintiff was represented by KAY KAREN KENNEDY, the defendant, MAURICE LYLE PETER, JR., M.D., appeared in person and with his attorney, DAVID CHEEK.

A proposed order, signed by the defendant, his attorney and the attorney for the plaintiff was submitted to this Board. A copy of said proposed order is attached hereto.

Based upon the stipulation presented by the parties, the Board finds that MAURICE LYLE PETER JR., M.D. is guilty of unprofessional conduct. The Board accepts the proposed order offered by the parties.

IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS THAT:


1. License Number 7123, issued to MAURICE LYLE PETER, JR., M.D., will be suspended for a period of thirty (30) days, said suspension to commence on the 1st day of October 1979, and to terminate on the 31st day of October 1979.
2. Dr. Peter will be placed on probation for a five year term which will commence on the 1st day of November 1979 and will terminate of the 31st day of October 1984.
3. Dr. Peter will provide urine and blood specimens to Inspectors of the State Board of Medical Examiners upon request.
4. Dr. Peter will report to the Medical Board whenever requested to do so.
5. Dr. Peter is prohibited from prescribing, administering or dispensing all Narcotic drugs(as defined in 63 O.S. 1975 Supp. § 2-101 (21) from the date of this Order through the five year probationary term, except Dr. Peter may write hospital orders for narcotic drugs to be administered by the staff of the hospital for hospital in-patients.
6. Dr. Peter must keep duplicate, serially numbered prescriptions for all Schedule II through Scchdule V drugs prescribed either by telephone or written prescriptions and make the same available for inspection by the Medical Board or its agents upon request.
7. Dr. Peter will authorize his psychiatrist to make reports to the Board of Medical Examiners upon request of the Board.
