




controlled dangerous substances in excess of the amount considered good medical practice and/or without sufficient medical need in accordance with published standards on patients W.S., H.S., N.R., D.C., and B.J.

4. That Defendant did not keep complete and accurate records of purchase and disposal of controlled drugs or narcotic drugs as required by law.

5. That Defendant failed to maintain controlled dangerous substances and/or narcotics in a secure place in his office and did not maintain a biannual inventory of controlled dangerous substances and/or narcotics as required by law.

6. That the above in addition to other patient records reveal that scheduled drugs were being prescribed in excess of the amount considered for the medical need presented.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing and upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such disciplinary action be taken by the Board as is authorized by law.
