**ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF
MEDICAL LICENSE**

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on January 29, 2004, at the Board office, 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73118, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

John T. Forsythe, Applicant, appeared in person and pro se.

Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

Applicant previously held Oklahoma Medical License No. 7562.

2. On September 24, 1998, the Board revoked Defendant's license based upon his plea of no contest to charges of numerous violations of 59 O.S. §509 and the Oklahoma Administrative Code.

3 Applicant has applied for reinstatement of his license.

4. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. §480 et seq.
2. The Applicant has failed to sustain his burden of proof that he has met all requirements for reinstatement of his medical license, including, but not limited to the requirement that he be of good moral character.


ORDER
