# ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on March 27, 2003, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Jerry Raymond Nida, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 7619, appeared in person and with his legal counsel, Laura Cross.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Dr.Nida currently holds medical license no. 7619 under a three (3) year term of probation that commenced on or around May 14, 2002.
- 3. Dr. Nida has requested that his probation be terminated based upon the fact that his three (3) year probation with the District Court of Oklahoma County had been lifted.
- 4. Tom Sosbee, Compliance and Education Coordinator for the Board, testified that Dr. Nida had complied to date with the terms of probation and that the Board staff did not object to the requested termination.
- 5. Dr. Nida has complied to date in all respects with the terms of probation, and the purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished. Dr. Nida has presented sufficient evidence to support the requested early termination.

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.

2. Dr. Nida has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of the remainder of his probationary period. The purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished by Dr. Nida's compliance with the probationary terms. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Nida serve the remainder of his probationary term.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Dr. Nida's application to terminate probation is **GRANTED** and his probationary period is terminated effective March 27, 2003.
