ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc on the 15th day of September, 1988, at the office of the Oklahoma State Medical Association, 601 NW Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Lawrence A. Reed, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person, pro se, without counsel and advised he was ready to proceed without the assistance of counsel.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard testimony and reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That Defendant, Lawrence A. Reed, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 7688.
- 2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. That on or around May 1, 1987, Defendant was placed on probation for a period of three (3) years on the general terms that he was to keep duplicate, serially-numbered prescriptions for all controlled dangerous substances prescribed and make those records available to any investigator of the Board, to furnish current legal addresses to the Board, appear before the Board or designated member whenever requested, submit any reports required by the Investigative Division on a timely basis, and substantially reduce the number of controlled dangerous substance prescriptions being written.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

That Defendant, Lawrence A. Reed, M.D., is lawfully under the jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision originally for a term of three (3) years beginning on May 1, 1987, and it is within the power and discretion of the Board to modify terms and conditions of probation and to terminate probation upon receipt of sufficient evidence.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- That the Defendant, Lawrence A. Reed, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 7688, be and the same is hereby terminated from probation originally imposed on May 1, 1987.
- Effective date of termination of probation is September 15, 1988.
- A copy of this Order should be sent to Defendant and placed in the public file so the termination of probation is a matter of record.
