FINAL ORDER RETAINING TERMS OF PROBATION

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc on the 22nd day of January, 1988, at the office of the Oklahoma State Medical Association, 601 NW Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff, and David E. Rutledge, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person, pro se for the Defendant.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard the testimony and reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That Defendant, David E. Rutledge, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 7726.
- 2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. That Defendant to date has fulfilled all terms and conditions of probation originally imposed for a three (3) year basis beginning January 17, 1987, however, the Defendant failed to produce sufficient evidence to warrant any ending or termination of probation and the Defendant's request for same should be OVERRULED.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has inherent power to modify or shorten or to not modify or shorten the terms and the period of probation of any Defendant under Board jurisdiction, 59 O.S. Supp. 1987, \$506 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That probation of three (3) years previously imposed on the Defendant on January 17, 1987, should be and the same is hereby retained and kept in full force and effect.

2. That the Defendant may re-apply to the Board at a future date for modification or termination of probation.
