
Dear Doctor Bowlan:

The Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners, in regular session on June 14, 1974, took the following action:

***motion was duly made, seconded, and carried, that he be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years, with the provisions that he comply with the regulations of the Medical Practice Act and the Federal and State Drug Laws, and that he appear before the Board when he is requested to do so, unless excused by the Secretary of the Board. Further conditions of the probation are that he keep detailed narcotic records, including duplicate copies of prescriptions on all controlled drugs. Failure to comply with the provisions of the probation will result in the automatic revocation of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma".

The Board also feels you should be warned again of the dangers which could result from the signing of blank prescriptions, as well as the illegal aspects involved.
