COMPLAINT

COMES NOW J.G. Landreth, Investigator for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, being first duly sworn upon oath and states:

1. That Walter L. Bowlan, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 7772, is in violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981, Sec. 509, Paragraph 15, to-wit

"15. Aiding or abetting, directly or indirectly, the practice of medicine by any person not duly authorized under the laws of Oklahoma."

2. That during August, 1991, Defendant did unlawfully aid and abet the practice of medicine of his son, Timothy Mark Bowlan, an unlicensed person in the State of Oklahoma

3. That Defendant is perpetuating significant harm to public health, safety, and welfare by continuing the acts and omissions set forth in the above allegations

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing and upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such disciplinary action be taken by the Board as is authorized by law.
