Dear Doctor Thiessen:

The State Board of Medical Examiners, in regular session on February 5, 1977, took the following action:

"\*\*\*motion was duly made, seconded, and carried, that he be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, with the provisions that he comply with the regulations of the Medical Practice Act and the Federal and State Drug Laws, that he make adequate examinations and establish valid doctor-patient relationships, that he not write any prescriptions for amphetamines, that he use no medication unless prescribed by another physician, and that he appear before the Board when requested to do so, unless excused by the Secretary of the Board. Failure to comply with the provisions of the probation will result in the automatic revocation of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma".
