In connection with your application for the reinstatement of your Oklahoma Medical License, the State Board of Medical Examiners, in meeting on April 20, 1979, took the following action:

- " \*\*\* motion was duly made, seconded, and passed, that the Oklahoma Medical License Number 7787 of Harold Dean Thiessen, M.D., be reinstated on probation for a period of three (3) years with the following terms:
  - 1. That he not use alcohol in any form.
  - 2. That he use no medication without a prescription from and the advice of his physician.
  - 3. That he continue in a therapy situation, report regularly to the Board and authorize his psychiatrist to report to the Board.
  - 4. That he apply for no DEA permit except under Schedules 4 and 5.
  - 5. That he submit to random blood and urine samples on request.
  - 6. That he appear before the Board when requested to do so,
  - 7. That any violation of the terms of the probation will result in a citation to revoke his license to practice medicine in the State of Oklahoma".
