Dear Doctor Thiessen:

In connection with your application for the reinstatement of your Oklahoma Medical License, the State Board of Medical Examiners, in meeting on April 20, 1979, took the following action:

- " *** motion was duly made, seconded, and passed, that the Oklahoma Medical License Number 7787 of Harold Dean Thiessen, M.D., be reinstated on probation for a period of three (3) years with the following terms:
1. That he not use alcohol in any form.
 2. That he use no medication without a prescription from and the advice of his physician.
 3. That he continue in a therapy situation, report regularly to the Board and authorize his psychiatrist to report to the Board.
 4. That he apply for no DEA permit except under Schedules 4 and 5.
 5. That he submit to random blood and urine samples on request.
 6. That he appear before the Board when requested to do so.
 7. That any violation of the terms of the probation will result in a citation to revoke his license to practice medicine in the State of Oklahoma".
