ORDER

NOW on this 15th day of May, 1982, comes on for hearing the above styled cause before the State Board of Medical Examiners. The Defendant, HAROLD D. THIESSEN, M.D., appeared in person and with his attorneys, D.C. Thomas and Merle Gile. The Board after carefully considering the verified Answer of the Defendant, considering the statements of the Defendant, hearing arguments of counsel, and being duly informed in the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

The Board of Medical Examiners finds that HAROLD D. THIESSEN, M.D., is in violation of the Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981 S 509, paragraph 5 and has violated paragraph 2 of the Order of this Board issued on the 20th day of April, 1979.

THEREFORE, IT IS THE ORDER OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS that the Medical License of HAROLD D. THIESSEN, M.D., Medical License No. 7787, be and is hereby suspended and the case continued to the September 1982 meeting of the Board. At the reconvened hearing, the Board shall consider the status of the medical license and take any further disciplinary action as may be warranted. Dr. Thiessen is directed to authorize his personal physicians and personnel of any rehabilitation center attended to make reports to this Board regarding the status of his medical condition prior to the September 1982 Board meeting.
