## FINAL ORDER

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc on September 30, 1983, at 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff and Lee Cate, Attorney, appeared for the Defendant.

The counsel for the parties then advised the Board of Medical Examiners of a proposed disposition of this case. Said proposal is hereby adopted and the Board of Medical Examiners issues the following Order:

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical examiners of Oklahoma as follows:

- 1. That the Defendant, Griffith C. Miller, M.D., License No. 7796, be and is hereby placed on probation to the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners for a period of five years, beginning on September 30, 1983, under the following terms and conditions:
  - a. During the period of probation it is required that Dr. Miller comply with the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act as interpreted by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners and that he appear before the Board or its designated representative upon request.
  - b. During the period of probation Dr. Miller will furnish to the office of the State Board of Medical Examiners all current legal addresses and any change of address in writing.
  - c. During the period of probation Dr. Miller will keep duplicate, serially-numbered, prescriptions of all controlled, dangerous substances, readily retrievable, in numerical order and will furnish duplicates to Inspectors or other authorized agents of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical examiners immediately upon request.
  - d. During the period of probation Dr. Miller will write no prescriptions for anorectic or amphetamine drugs.

e. A copy hereof will be mailed to the office staff of Dr. Miller in order that the staff may be advised of all terms and conditions contained herein.
