# **ORDER MODIFYING PROBATION**

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on January 29, 2004, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Kailash Chandra Sahoo, O.T., holding Oklahoma license no. OT779, appeared not. Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

# FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Mr. Sahoo currently holds Oklahoma license no. OT779 under a two-year term of probation that commenced July 17, 2003.
- 3. The State has requested that the terms of Mr. Sahoo's probation be modified to delete the requirement that he enter and continue counseling for sexual awareness, in that he has completed this counseling.

4. The State presented sufficient evidence to support the requested modification.

# CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq. and 888.1 et seq.
- 2. The State has presented satisfactory evidence to justify modifying Mr. Sahoo's probation to delete the requirement that he enter and continue counseling for sexual awareness.

### **ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. The State's application to modify the terms of Mr. Sahoo's probation is GRANTED.
- 2. Mr. Sahoo's probation shall continue for two (2) years from the date of its commencement of July 17, 2003 under the terms and conditions set forth in the July 17, 2003 Order, with the exception that Mr. Sahoo is no longer required to enter and continue counseling for sexual awareness.
- 3. Failure to meet any of the terms of this Order will be grounds for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke Mr. Sahoo's occupational therapy license, after additional notice and hearing as required by law.
- 4. A copy of this written order should be sent to Mr. Sahoo as soon as it is processed.
