DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on October 26, 1990, at the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Charles Caleb Elliott, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person and by counsel, Robert McCune, of Stipe, Gossett, Stipe, Harper, Estes, McCune & Parks, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard the oral argument of counsel, reviewed exhibits, and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Charles Caleb Elliott, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 7914.
2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
3. That the Board found the present case that was initiated by Complaint filed on August 22, 1990, should be dismissed without prejudice.
4. That the Board makes no finding or ruling on any of the merits of the Complaint and Citation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1989, Sec. 481 et seq., and the Board may dismiss without prejudice any action that is before it.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the Complaint filed herein against the Defendant on August 22, 1990, should be and the same is hereby DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.


2. That the Board staff should provide Defendant a copy of this order by mailing same to his counsel.
