FINAL ORDER

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on November 1, 1991, at the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Joe Bills Reynolds, M.D., Defendant, appeared by way of announcement by his counsel, Garvin A. Isaacs.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard the statements of counsel and being fully advised in the premises, the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Joe Bills Reynolds, M.D., originally held Oklahoma Medical License No. 7938.

2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That following hearing and presentation of sworn evidence and exhibits on March 17, 1990, the Board suspended Dr. Reynolds' Oklahoma medical license until further hearing on June 8, 1990.

4. That Defendant obtained continuance of the hearing scheduled for June 8, 1990, until October 26 and 27, 1990, and the suspension of license remained in force and effect. Defendant obtained continuance of the October, 1990, hearing until final disposition of charges pending in Oklahoma County District Court in <u>State v. Reynolds</u>, CF-90-2626, and suspension remained in force and effect.

5. That on June 18, 1991, Defendant was convicted of Second Degree Manslaughter in the District Court of Oklahoma County.

6. That Defendant stated in a letter to Board counsel of June 19, 1991, that he voluntarily surrendered his Oklahoma license to practice medicine.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the acts and omissions of the Defendant as previously found by the Board, and the Defendant's conviction of Second Degree Manslaughter form the basis for the Board to impose sanction on the Defendant's license as authorized by law, 59 O.S. Supp. 1990, Sec. 481 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That Oklahoma Medical License No. 7938 of the Defendant, Joe Bills Reynolds, M.D., previously suspended by this Board, should be and is hereby REVOKED.

2. That the Board staff should serve a copy of this Order on the Defendant promptly, either in person, or to Defendant's counsel of record, Garvin A. Isaacs.
