IT IS THE ORDER OF THE OKLAHOMA STATE BOARD OF PODIATRY that the above-captioned case be and is hereby continued to a date to be set after July 1, 1984.

IT IS THE FURTHER ORDER OF THE BOARD that during the interim from December 8, 1983, to final adjudication of this matter, the following terms be imposed as stipulated and agreed to by Willis:

1. That Robert T. Willis, D.P.M., holding License No. be placed on probation for a three-year period of time.

2. That Dr. Willis refrain from administering, prescribing or dispensing any narcotic drug.

3. That Dr. Willis enroll in a full pharmacology course offered by any institution of the healing arts and document his enrollment and completion of said course to the Board.

4. That Dr. Willis maintain duplicate copies of all scheduled prescriptions written and make said copies available to any member of the Board when requested to do so.

5. That Dr. Willis appear before the Board when requested to do so.
