Dear Doctor Bridwell:

The State Board of Medical Examiners, in regular session on May 28, 1977, took the following action:

"Statement was made that on the complaint filed, Doctor Malcolm Edward Bridwell, holding Oklahoma Medical License Number 8313, is guilty of unprofessional conduct, to wit, violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1971, §509, more specifically Sub-Sections 6 and 8 as follows: Sub-Section 6, conviction of a felony or of offense involving moral turpitude; Sub-Section 8, conviction or the confession of a crime involving the violation of the anti-narcotic or prohibition laws, regulations of the Federal Government or the Board of Health, and laws and regulations of the State of Oklahoma, in that on April 22, 1977, Doctor Malcolm Edward Bridwell was convicted of a felony in the Federal Court, Western District of Oklahoma, and that the Board has received a certified copy of that conviction, therefore, motion was duly made, seconded, voted individually and unanimously by all of the Board Members, and thus carried, that his license to practice medicine in the State of Oklahoma be revoked".
