### ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Medical Board of Licensure and Supervision on January 16, 2014, at the office of the Board, 101 N.E. 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board. Defendant, Jaemie Ann Waters, P.A., appeared in person.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the Motion and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, conclusions of Law, and Orders:

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and rules of the Board.
- 2. On July 19, 2007, after a hearing before the Board *en banc*, the Board entered an Revised Final Order of Probation based upon allegations of misconduct contained in the complaint filed May 4, 2007.
- 3. On November 3, 2011, Defendant appeared before the Board *en banc* and requested modification of terms of indefinite probation, which was granted in the Order Modifying Probation filed November 18, 2011.

- 4. Defendant is seeking to terminate the indefinite probation that commenced on July 19, 2007.
- 5. After hearing testimony the Board has determined that it is appropriate to terminate Defendant's probation.

### **Conclusions of Law**

1. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 59 O.S. §480 et seq. The Board may also modify, or remove entirely, previously placed restrictions.

#### <u>Order</u>

It is therefore **ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Defendant's probation, the terms of which are described in the Revised Final Order of Probation filed August 16, 2007, and in the Order Modifying Probation filed November 18, 2011, is hereby terminated.
