COMPLAINT

COMES NOW D. C. Mosshart, Inspector for the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners, being first duly sworn upon oath and states:

 That Roger L. Kinney, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 8626, is in violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981, \$509, Paragraph 8, to-wit:

"8. Conviction or confession of a crime involving a violation of the antinarcotic or prohibition laws and regulations of the federal government or the Board of Health laws and regulations of the State of Oklahoma."

That on or around November 1, 1985, the Defendant in Case No. 85-CR-106-01-BT in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma did plead guilty to violation of Title 21 U.S.C., §846 and §841(a)(1), Title 18 U.S.C., §2(b), and Title 26 U.S.C., §7201, and was sentenced to 13 four year sentences to run concurrently and 13 special parole terms of four years to run concurrently and the Court further ordered that the Defendant be placed in an institution that has a drug treatment and supervision program and that the Defendant take part in same and that said conviction involved the violation of antinarcotic laws of the federal government of the United States of America. WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing and upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such disciplinary action be taken by the Board as is authorized by law.
