of successful completion of inpatient treatment at an approved

with or without additional probationary terms

is made without any duress or promise by any representative of
the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners

2. That the Defendant should obtain a complete physical and emotional examination from a physician of his choice outside of his own immediate geographical area, and further that the Defendant should initiate an exercise program and maintain the aforesaid program.

3. That the Board is presently taking under consideration whether an order should issue that Dr. Sanders undergo a formal, in-patient program relating to his alcohol use. That the Board will reconsider this case at 10:00 a.m. on May 24, 1985, and that the Defendant must be present at that time and that the Board retains jurisdiction to make additional terms of probation and to consider additional actions against the medical license of the Defendant.
