

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1995, Sec. 481 et seq., and that continuance of a hearing is within the sound discretion of the Board and that evidence presented herein does support Defendant's Application for Continuance.


ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That hearing on the matter involving Defendant, Mary Ann Gilliam, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 9089, should be and the same is hereby CONTINUED until the next meeting of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision presently scheduled for March 22-23, 1996.


