That said Board finds that JOE GREER SAVAGE. did not use drugs to excess that impaired his abili to practice medicine reasonable degree of skill and safety

JOE GREER SAVAGE is gui ty of unprofessional conduct in that he has violated Rule 29 Subsec (a) and (b) of the Rules Regulat of this Board to will indiscriminate excessive prescribing of control narcotic drugs and prescription of lied narcotic drugs in of considered good medical practice

IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER THE ORIGINAL STATE BOARD MEDICAL EXAMINERS
THAT JOE GREER SAVAGE LICENSE #9266 PLACED ON TERM PROPATION FOR
THREE YEARS WITH THE TERMS HIS PROPATION FOLLOWS

- 1. That Dr. SAVAGE will not prescribe or administer any drugs to himself; he will take medication only from the prescription of a licensed medical physician with whom he has established a valid patient-physician relationship.
- 2. That JOE GREER SAVAGE, M.D., not take any psychotrophic drugs unless they are prescribed by a psychiatrist.
- 3. That he will submit to random blood and urine samples upon request for drug screening.
- 4. That he will keep duplicate, serially-numbered prescriptions of all controlled drugs that he prescribes and a list of all controlled drugs which he administers or dispenses and furnish these to the Board upon request
 - 5. That he appear before the Board when requested to do so.
- 6. That any violation of the terms of his probation will result in a citation being issued with the purpose of revocation of Dr. SAVAGE's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED BY THE BOARD that JOE GREER SAVAGE, M.D. continue seeing a psychiatrist until the psychiatrist feels that he no longer needs his care.
