ORDER


NOW on this 18th day of September, 1982, comes on for hearing before the State Board of Medical Examiners the above styled and captioned cause. John B. Freidenberger, M.D., appeared in person, pro se. Dr. Freidenberger presented a Motion for Continuance prepared by his attorney Thomas Dee Frasier. The Board granted the Motion insofar as the Request to continue the hearing on the Complaint and Citation filed in August 1982. The Board then heard testimony of the Defendant to determine if the suspension, Ordered by the Board in May 1982, should be enforced. Being duly informed in the premises, the Board entered the following Order.

IT IS THE ORDER OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS that the hearing on the Complaint and Citation filed in August 1982 be and is hereby continued to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.

IT IS THE FURTHER ORDER OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS that the Medical License of John B. Freidenberger, M.D., Medical License No. 9270, be and is hereby suspended immediately for a six (6) month period of time as previously ordered by the Board on May 14, 1982; subsequent to the six (6) month suspension, Dr. Freidenberger will be on probation for a period of five (5) years with the following terms and conditions:

1. That Dr. Freidenberger is to continue with rehabilitation for his alcohol addiction, including participation in programs offered by Alcoholics Anonymous.
2. That Dr. Freidenberger is to appear monthly before a designated member of this Board and is to provide to the Board reports from his psychiatrist or any professional person responsible for his rehabilitation program.

3. That Dr. Freidenberger is to continue his psychiatric treatment.
4. That Dr. Freidenberger is to refrain from the personal use of alcohol.
5. That Dr. Freidenberger is to refrain from taking any medication unless prescribed by his personal physician.
6. That Dr. Freidenberger is to submit biological specimens for analysis to an Inspector of this Board when requested to do so.
