

5. On or about May 25, 2006, pursuant to her employer's request, Defendant resigned her position with the Absentee Shawnee Tribe.

6. Based on the allegations stated above, Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct as follows:


- A. Abused alcohol or drugs in any manner which detrimentally affects the provision of nutritional services in violation of 59 O.S. §1738(A)(2) and OAC 435:35-1-4(c)(1)(F).
- B. Failed to comply with the provisions of the Oklahoma Controlled Substances Act in violation of 59 O.S. §1738(A)(2) and OAC 435:35-1-4(c)(1)(G).

7. These allegations raise serious concerns about Defendant's ability to practice as a dietitian in the State of Oklahoma with reasonable skill and safety.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff requests that the Board conduct a hearing, and upon proof of the allegations contained herein, impose such disciplinary action as authorized by law, up to and including suspension or revocation, the assessment of costs and fees incurred in this action, and any other appropriate action with respect to Defendant's license to practice as a dietitian in the State of Oklahoma.
