O R D E R

NOW on this 24th day of January, 1981, comes on for hearing the above styled and captioned cause. The plaintiff was represented by its attorney, Kay Karen Kennedy; the defendant, Perry Thomas Taaca, Jr., M.D., appeared in person and with his attorney Dean Brown.

After careful consideration of all testimony offered, review of the Judgment and Sentence from the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma with the accompanying Docket Sheet and Information, and the statements made by the defendant, the Board, being duly informed in the premises, unanimously found that Perry Thomas Taaca, JR., M.D., was guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he violated the Medical Practice Act of the State of Oklahoma, 59 O.S. 1980 Supp. § 509 as alleged in the Complaint. The deliberation of the Board, contained in the record of the hearing, is hereby incorporated herein.

Based on the findings of the Board, the following Order was issued:

The license of Perry Thomas Taaca, Jr., M.D., Medical License Number 9474, be revoked. Said revocation will become effective on the 7th day of February, 1981.
