ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc on May 24, 1985, at 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff and Perry Thomas Taaca, M.D., appeared pro se for the Defendant.

The Board of Medical Examiners en banc heard the testimony and reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises the Board of Medical Examiners therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Perry Thomas Taaca, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 9474.

2. That the Board of Medical Examiners en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That following notice and hearing held on or around September 11, 1981, Defendant was placed on probation for a period of five years under the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Dr. Taaca is to report to the Board when requested to do so;
- 2) Dr. Taaca is hereby prohibited from registering for a Federal or State permit in Schedule II or III drugs;
- 3) Dr. Taaca is to comply with the Medical Practice Act and the State and Federal Narcotics Laws;
- 4) Any violation of the terms of the probation will result in a Complaint and Citation being filed and appropriate action taken.

4. That from that time until this date the Defendant has fulfilled all terms and conditions of his probation.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. That since being placed on probation on or around September 11, 1981, Defendant has practiced medicine and surgery in Oklahoma in compliance with the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act and in compliance with the specific terms of the aforesaid probation.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Examiners of Oklahoma as follows:


1. That the Defendant, Perry Thomas Taaca, M.D., License No. 9474, be and is hereby released from the probation to the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners imposed on September 11, 1981, and all terms and conditions thereof.
