



4. Said Final Order is still in force and effect and has not been amended, modified or vacated by the Board.

5. Following notice and hearing on or around September 21, 1989, the Board found that Defendant failed to comply with terms of the Board Order concerning collection of bodily fluids and in informing hospital administrators of Board action, however said actions were not found to have willfully violated the Board's Order and therefore Defendant was not in contempt thereof and therefore no finding of contempt was made and no punitive action or additional sanction was taken against the Defendant.

6. That the Board staff was ordered to review compliance efforts of the Defendant henceforth and should report to the Board within six months of the nature and extent of Defendant's fulfillment of terms and conditions enumerated in the Board's Order following hearing on June 9, 1989, to determine Defendant's fulfillment of the aforesaid terms and conditions.

7. That Ralph Baldwin, Compliance Consultant, testified that Defendant had been in compliance with the terms of the Board Order in submitting of biological fluids and monthly reports. No further action was recommended.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That under the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1989, Sec. 481 et seq., the Board has authority to monitor compliance with terms and conditions of its own prior orders.

2. That the aforesaid testimony and evidence is merely a report to the Board as requested by the Board and does not constitute any basis for any additional sanction against the Defendant.


#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:


