ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on January 14, 2010, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Howard Edward Hagglund, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 9798, appeared in person and pro se.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

2. Dr. Hagglund currently holds medical license no. 9798 under an indefinite term of probation that commenced on January 17, 2008. Dr. Hagglund's Final Order of Probation provides that at the end of one (1) year, he was to appear before the Board so that it could review his practices and compliance with the probationary terms.

3. On March 26, 2009, Dr. Hagglund and the State requested that his probation be terminated. The Board denied Dr. Hagglund and the State's request for termination of his probation. The Board ordered that Dr. Hagglund's probation should be extended for an additional year after which time he should appear before the Board so that it could review his practices and compliance with the probationary terms.

4. On January 14, 2010, Dr. Hagglund again requested that the terms of his probation be terminated.

5. Tom Sosbee, Compliance and Education Coordinator for the Board, testified that Dr. Hagglund had complied to date with the terms of probation.

6. Dr. Hagglund has complied to date in all respects with the terms of probation, and the purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished. Dr. Hagglund has presented sufficient evidence to support the requested termination.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 *et seq.*

2. Dr. Hagglund has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of his probationary period. The purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished by Dr. Hagglund's compliance with the probationary terms. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Hagglund remain on probation.


ORDER

1. Dr. Hagglund's application to terminate probation is **GRANTED** and his probationary period is terminated effective upon payment of all outstanding probation costs and fees.


2. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Hagglund as soon as it is processed.
