

4. On October 15, 2012 Defendant answered incorrectly on her license renewal stating that she had obtained the required 20 hours of continuing education (“CEU”).
5. Defendant did not respond to several notices of the CEU audit with warning that non-response would generate further action.
6. Based on no response from the Defendant, the Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee recommended Board Staff file a Complaint. Said Complaint was filed against the Defendant on May 24, 2013 with the matter set to be heard on July 11, 2013.
7. Prior to the hearing date Defendant provided proof of eighteen (18) of the required twenty (20) hours.
8. Based on the Defendant obtaining an additional two (2) hours of CEU for the delinquent period and agreeing to the Occupational Therapist Advisory Committee to obtain an additional twenty (20) CEU hours (for a total of 40) between June 27, 2013 and October 31, 2014 with an automatic audit, Board Staff agreed to ask the Board to dismiss the Complaint.

Conclusions of Law


1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. §480 et seq.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. The Complaint filed against Defendant on May 23, 2013 is hereby dismissed.
