#### ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on June 27, 2013 at the Board office, 101 N.E. 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Rochelle Crip, OTA, Defendant, appeared not.

Lyle Kelsey, Executive Director of the Board, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders:

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. The Board en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board
- 2. Defendant holds Oklahoma occupational therapy assistant license no. OA997.
- 3. On October 12, 2012 Defendant was notified she had been selected for a random CEU audit and supporting documentation needed to be in the Board office for review no later than January 11, 2013.

- 4. On October 15, 2012 Defendant answered incorrectly on her license renewal stating that she had obtained the required 20 hours of continuing education ("CEU").
- 5. Defendant did not respond to several notices of the CEU audit with warning that non-response would generate further action.
- 6. Based on no response from the Defendant, the Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee recommended Board Staff file a Complaint. Said Complaint was filed against the Defendant on May 24, 2013 with the matter set to be heard on July 11, 2013.
- 7. Prior to the hearing date Defendant provided proof of eighteen (18) of the required twenty (20) hours.
- 8. Based on the Defendant obtaining an additional two (2) hours of CEU for the delinquent period and agreeing to the Occupational Therapist Advisory Committee to obtain an additional twenty (20) CEU hours (for a total of 40) between June 27, 2013 and October 31, 2014 with an automatic audit, Board Staff agreed to ask the Board to dismiss the Complaint.

### Conclusions of Law

1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. §480 et seq.

#### Order

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. The Complaint filed against Defendant on May 23, 2013 is hereby dismissed.
